*Headlight wells (remove shrouds)	9. Use mirror to see hard to access locations
*Battery tray (remove battery)	10. Listen for wheel bearing or other odd noises
*Side longitudinals (remove side valences)	11. Check brake system for leaks, swollen lines
*Behind bumpers (remove bumpers)	12. Check the radio /antenna function
*Footpedal area (remove pedalboard)	13. Check keylocks: One key operates all locks?
*Master cyl/steer. rack (remove cover panel)

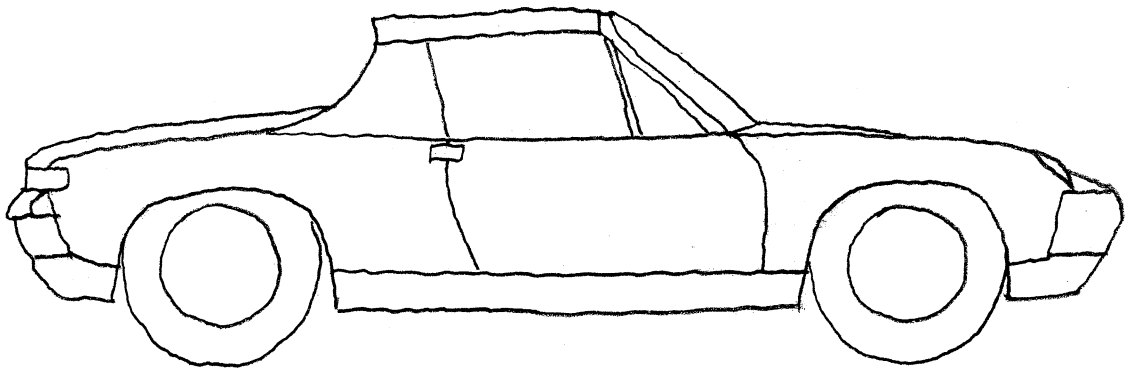

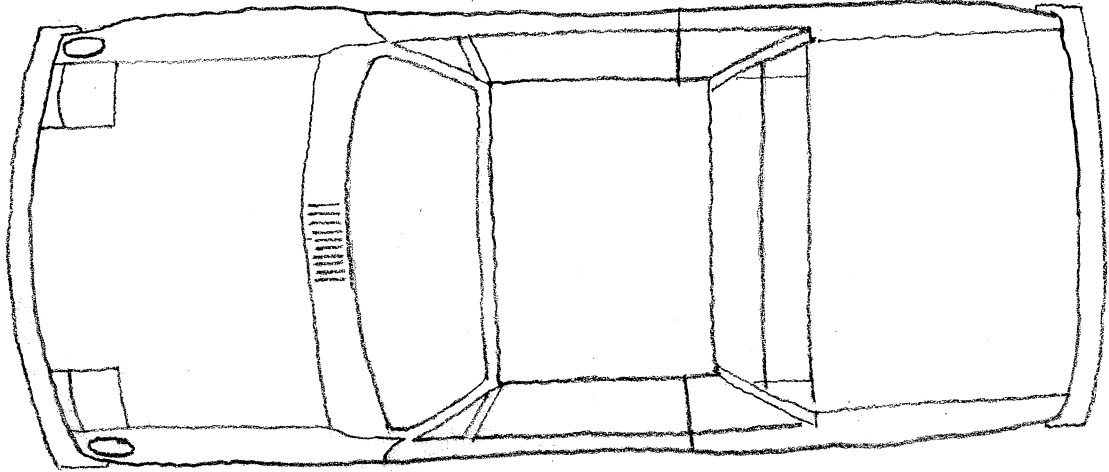

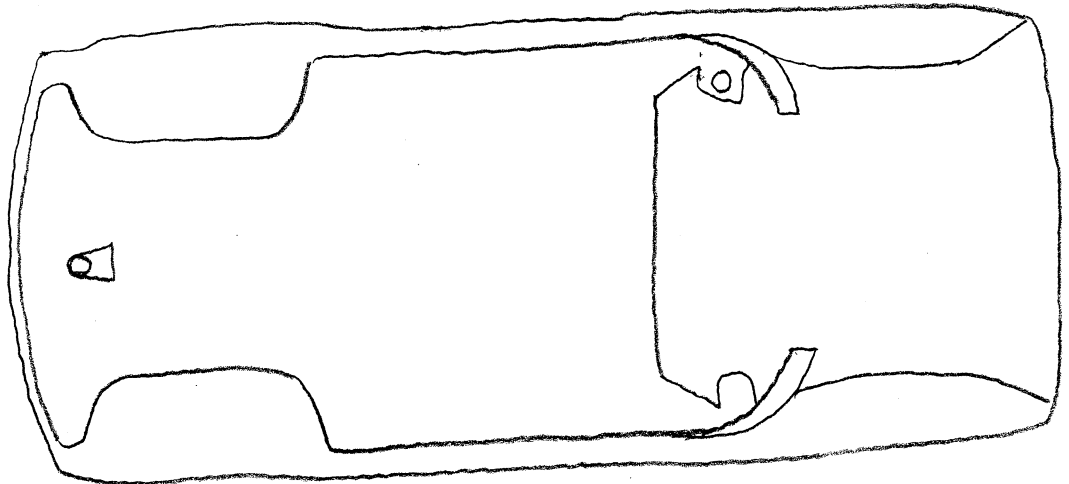

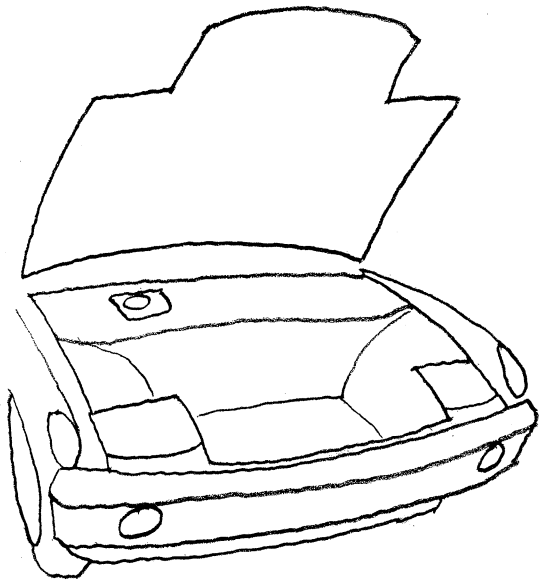

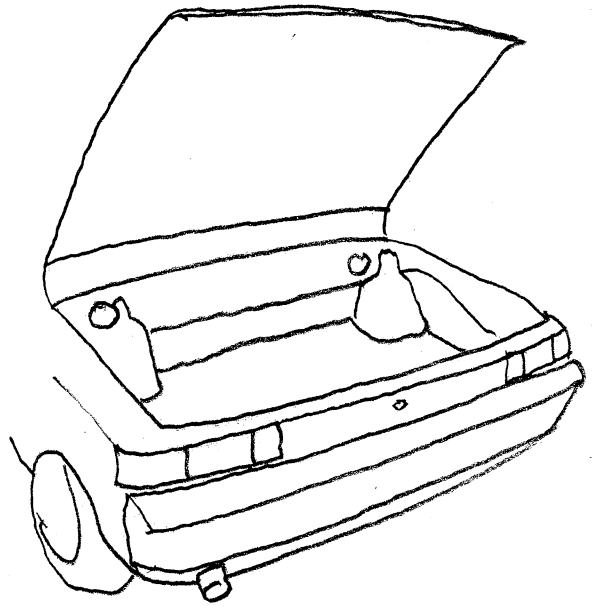

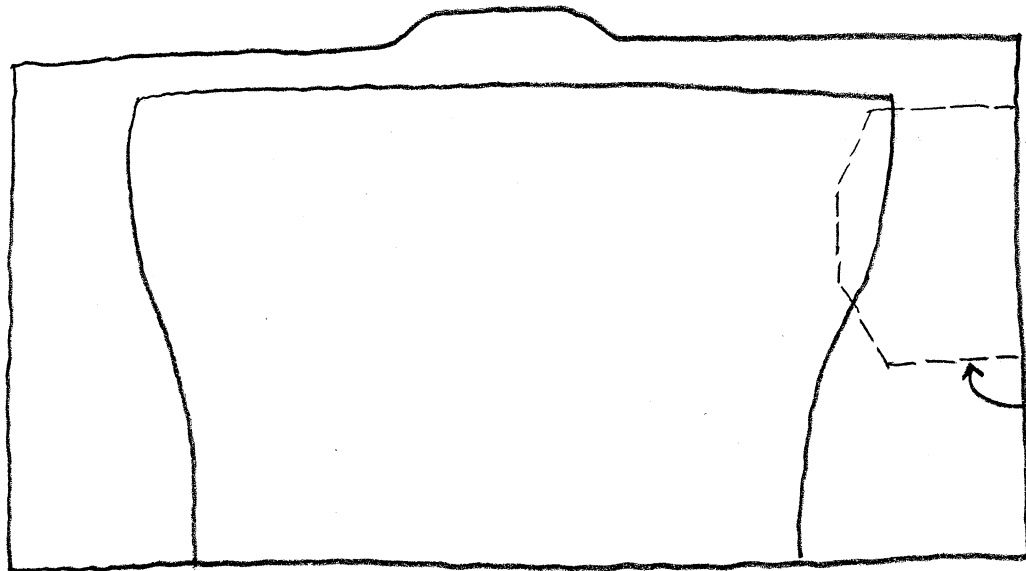

FRONT TRUNK

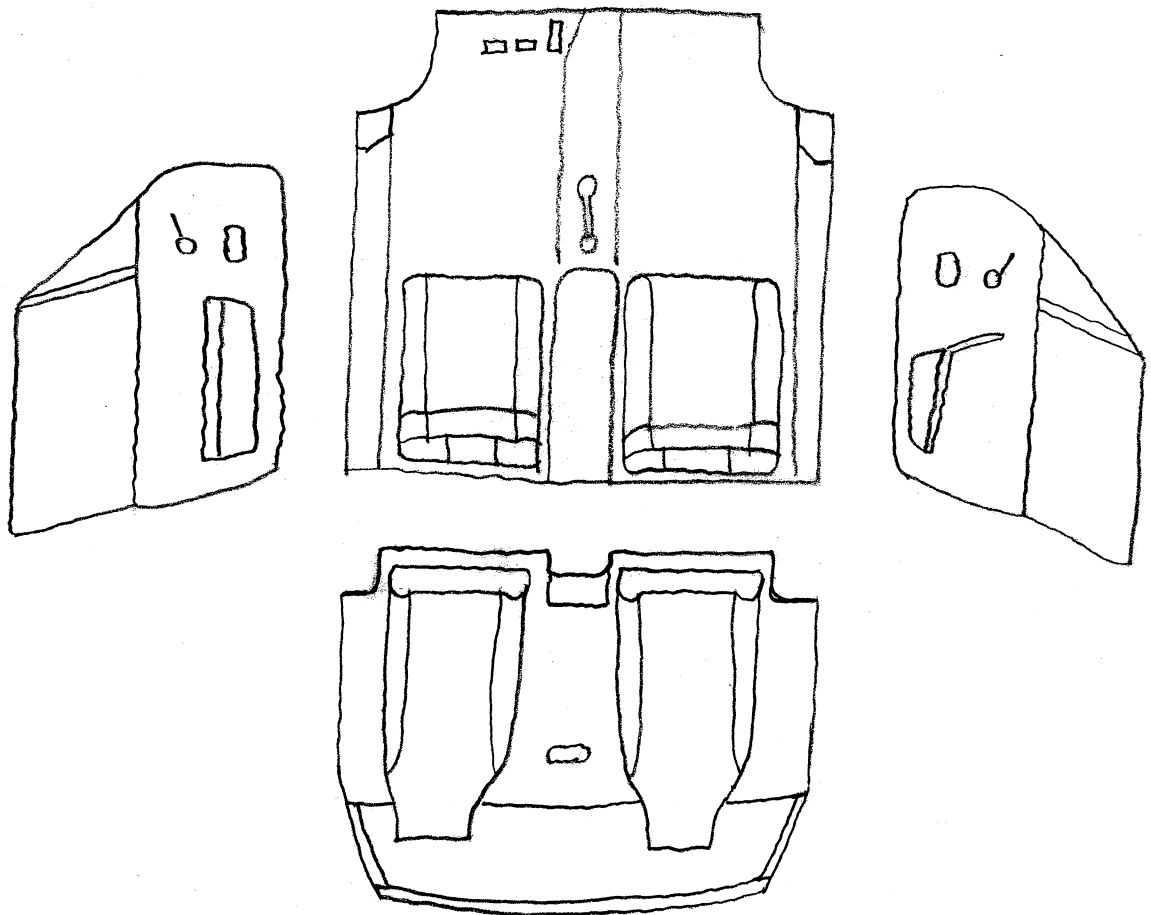
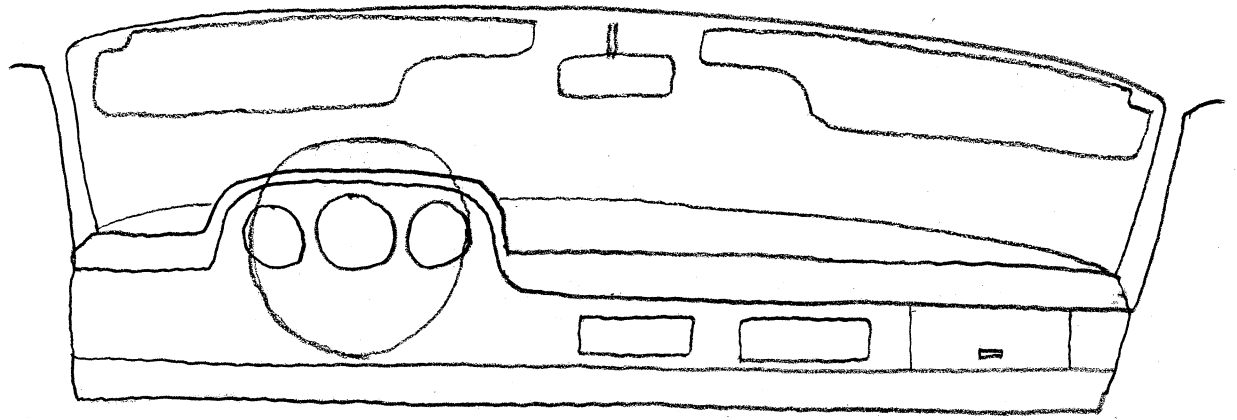


REAR TRUNK
